New Policy for CPR Classes

Effective Oct. 1, 2022, Providence hospitals will transition to a new CPR skills program called Resuscitation Quality Improvement Program (RQI). RQI is only available to employed caregivers; therefore, SJO will no longer offer on-site classes for BLS, ACLS or PALS certification or renewal to non-employees, including physicians and non-employed Allied Health and Advanced Practice Staff. 
