Your PSJO Campus Safety: Our #1 Priority

Security measures in place include:

Continuous Education: Security visited all departments and units to provide re-education on emergency codes, with a specific focus on Code Silver – Person with a Weapon or Hostage Situation. If you'd like a badge buddy with a listing of all emergency codes and Security phone number, please stop by Security or the Medical Staff Office.

Campus Access & Monitoring: Access to visitors continues to be restricted to the main entrances. Badge access is granted at specific entrances for caregivers during regular business hours. Access is restricted to main entrances-only for all nights and weekends (except for staff who respond to codes). Please re-direct people without the appropriate badge access to a main entrance. Video cameras throughout the campus are continuously monitored by Security.

We hope to never experience an active shooter (Code Silver); however, should this occur, run, hide, or fight to survive. If you see or hear something suspicious, say something. Internally, dial 66 to reach Security immediately, or call Security at 714-771-8050, or call 911.

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
