Acute Care Student Nurse Placement Coordinators & Nursing Instructors,

On September 18, 2021, PSJH NorCal hospitals are transitioning a new electronic medical record called Epic. The purpose of this memo is to provide information about Epic training for acute care nursing students. The  $2^{nd}$  page includes the steps for students to access training.

As with MEDITECH training, acute care nursing students will access PSJH Epic training online; however, there are 2 major changes to the current process:

- 1. Students will use a different website then what is currently used for MEDITECH training.
  - a. The current SoCal MEDITECH site will be inactivated on Sept. 13. A redirect message will be added to the site, but the new site below should be provided to students.
- 2. Student will need an PJSH network account to access the website used for Epic training.

## Student Nurse Epic Training Site:

Nursing students with clinical rotations in the acute care setting can access Epic training via this link <a href="Student Nurse Epic Training">Student Nurse Epic Training</a>

## Network Access:

Epic training content must be accessed through the PJSH network to comply with vendor copyright requirements. This means that student network accounts (UserIDs) *must be requested and provided before they can access Epic training*.

### Network Access Start Date:

When requesting network access, you should *align the network access start date with the date the student needs to access their Epic training*. For instance, if a student needs to access their training a week before their first clinical rotation day, then the network access start date should be set to that earlier date.

### Remote Network Access:

Students are asked to set up a Multifactor Authentication (MFA) code to access the PSJH network remotely (from a personal or school computer). A link to support this is included in the steps on page 2.

### Training Completion Tracking:

Academic institutions should track completion (i.e., by attestation). Completion of Epic training is not tracked on the website. Attestation sheets are not provided.

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# **Student Information**

#### Access:

- You will need your PSJH network UserID and Password to access your Epic training
- You should set up a Multifactor Authentication (MFA) code since it may be requested in case it is requested. To set up MFA go to this site: https://access.providence.org/

# Steps to Access Training

1. Click this link Student Nurse Epic Training

Use of a **Chrome** or **Edge** browser is recommended (see Technical Tips below)

- 2. Log in with your User Principal Name (UPN) & password
  - a. Your UPN is usually in this format network userID@providence.org
    - i. If that doesn't work, you can try first name.last name@providence.org
  - b. Enter a Multifactor Authentication (MFA) code if requested
- 3. Review the instructions on the Student (Nursing) training page and begin your training

# **Technical Tips for Viewing eLearnings**

eLearnings function differently on different devices and browsers and are dependent on internet speed. Below are recommendations to support optimum user-experience.

- ✓ Use Chrome or Chromium Edge browser
- ✓ Clear browser history before starting your training
- ✓ Do not pause excessively or fast forward/skip ahead, this can cause the lesson to freeze and may interfere with your ability to complete the lesson
- ✓ Complete all guizzes and follow all prompts
- ✓ When viewing a video, wait until the slider at the bottom stops before clicking continue.

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
