

2023 COMMUNITY BENEFIT SNAPSHOT

Providence Seaside Hospital and communities



In 2023, Providence Oregon continued its tradition of compassion and dedication to our communities, with Providence Seaside Hospital investing more than \$4.2 million to improve community health. These targeted investments included more than \$770,000 in community health services and \$2 million in free and low-cost care.

PROVIDENCE INVESTS IN OREGON'S HEALTH

INCREASING CHILDCARE ACCESS IN CLATSOP COUNTY

Providence helped fund the Clatsop County Childcare Initiative to address an extreme lack of local childcare. A community coalition distributed funds to 12 childcare organizations and potential providers to support childcare access and scholarships, and childcare employment benefits. The program served 305 children, increased provider capacity by 36% and saw a net gain of 110 hours of childcare staff time.

PROVIDING THE BASIC NECESSITIES FOR PEOPLE IN NEED

In 2023, Providence provided funds for Clatsop Community Action (CCA) to help people with housing, food and other basic living needs. Through the HUD Continuum of Care Housing program, CCA helped low-income families and individuals receive ongoing rent assistance and supportive services, and offered resources for homeless youth, chronically homeless families, families with disabilities and people fleeing domestic violence.

SUPPORTING A REENTRY PROGRAM FOR A MORE SUSTAINABLE LIFE


Providence funding aided Helping Hands Reentry in their work guiding people experiencing homelessness toward more sustainable lives through resources, and recovery and reentry programs. The referralbased services included emergency shelter but the main focus was on a long-term reentry program. In 2023, the group helped 192 people access 8,969 services and saw navigation services increase after opening a warming center in Seaside.
