Welcome to SJO's New Program Director of Vascular Neurology



Providence St. Joseph Hospital has broadened the Stroke Program's neurointerventional care to treat patients experiencing a hemorrhagic stroke, in addition to the care we provide for ischemic stroke. Neurointerventional care for hemorrhagic stroke requires a specialty-trained physician and team that can perform advanced procedures (including coil embolization). With the addition of **Dr. Wled Wazni**, Program Director of Vascular Neurology, we now provide this care in addition to other advanced procedures.

Dr. Wazni is board certified in vascular neurology and fellowship trained in interventional radiology, vascular neurology and neurocritical care.

New Year, New Notice to Patients Required as of Jan. 1, 2023

Recently approved regulations amended Title 16 of the California Code of Regulations section 1355.4 to require physicians licensed by the Medical Board of California to provide a notice to their patients about the role of the Board. The license can be checked and complaints against the licensee made by contacting the Board or through its website.

The notice shall include a quick response (QR) code to the Board's Notice to Consumer web page, www.mbc.ca.gov/licensing/Notice-to-Consumers.aspx and contain:

NOTICE TO PATIENTS

Medical doctors are licensed and regulated by the Medical Board of California.

To check up on a license or to file a complaint go to

www.mbc.ca.gov, email: licensecheck@mbc.ca.gov, or call (800) 633-2322.

Physicians are in compliance with this requirement by doing one of the following:

1) Posting the notice in an area visible to patients on the premises where the physician provides services in at least 38-point type in Arial font; or 2) Including the notice and an acknowledgment of receipt and understanding in a written statement, signed and dated by the patient or the patient representative and retained in that patient's medical records; or 3) Including notice in a language understood by the patient or patient representative in a statement on letterhead, discharge instructions or other document given to a patient/patient representative where it is placed immediately above the signature line in at least 14-point type.



Refining Dining – We are pleased to share that, after hearing concerns from our Medical Staff, we had multiple meetings with the Food Service and Administration to improve physician dining. Several upgrades have been made, including:

- Overnight availability of prepackaged items in the Doctors Dining Room M-F, 8 p.m. - 6 a.m.
- Improved night owl service/ options, and
- Adjusted meal cards to "per day" instead of "per meal."

As feedback comes in we will continue to partner on adding improvements wherever possible.

Providence physicians comprise over one-third of this year's OCMA Top Doctors – Congratulations to the 256 Providence physicians recognized this year by the Orange County Medical Association for their excellence. The listing of 738 "Top Doctors" in Orange County appears in the Jan. 2023 Orange Coast magazine.


